14. Recasting

An evidence-based strategy for helping children with jumbled up speech sounds



Recasting involves showing the child the right way to say the sound at least 2 or 3 times. This allows them to see & hear how the sound is made, without highlighting their error or making them feel embarrassed or upset.



Best times to practice recasting:

- 1:1 play
- Snack-time
- Looking through picture books together
