

Attendant, Multi-Task (Grade Code 6015)

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 22 of the Health Act 2004, I hereby approve the qualifications, as set out hereunder, for the appointment and continuing as **Attendant, Multi-Task.**

1. Professional Qualifications, Experience, etc

- (a) Eligible applicants will be those who on the closing date for the competition:
 - (i) Possess the relevant QQI Further Education and Training (FET) Level 5 Certificate in Health Service Skills.

or

(ii) FETAC Level 5 Certificate in Health Service Skills or Healthcare Support.

or

(iii)A relevant healthcare qualification.

or

(iv)Be currently employed an an Attendant, Multi-Task or a comparable role and be willing to undertake a QQI/FET Level 5 programme in Health Service skills or equivalent.

and

(b) Candidates must have the personal competence and capacity to properly discharge the duties of the role.

2. <u>Age</u>

Age restriction shall only apply to a candidate where s/he is not classified as a new entrant (within the meaning of the Public Service Superannuation (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 2004). A candidate who is not classified as a new entrant must be under 65 years of age on the first day of the month in which the latest date for receiving completed application forms for the office occurs.

3. Health

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be fully competent and capable of undertaking the duties attached to the office and be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service.

4. Character Candidates for and any person holding the office must be of good character.
