



**Chiropodist/Podiatrist
Grade Code 3352**

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 22 of the Health Act 2004, I hereby approve the qualifications, as set out hereunder, for the appointment and continuing as **Chiropodist/Podiatrist** in the Health Service Executive.

1. Statutory Registration, Professional Qualifications, Experience, etc

(a) Eligible applicants will be those who on the closing date for the competition:

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| (i) | Be registered, or be eligible for registration, on the Podiatrists Register maintained by the Podiatrists Registration Board at CORU. |
| AND | |
| (ii) | Have the requisite knowledge and ability (including a high standard of suitability and professional ability) for the proper discharge of the duties of the office. |
| AND | |
| (iii) | Provide proof of Statutory Registration on the Podiatrists Register maintained by the Podiatrists Registration Board at CORU <u>before a contract of employment can be issued.</u> |

2. Annual Registration

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| (i) | Practitioners must maintain annual registration on the Podiatrists Register maintained by the Podiatrists Registration Board at CORU. |
| AND | |
| (ii) | Confirm annual registration with CORU to the HSE by way of the annual Patient Safety Assurance Certificate (PSAC). |

3. Health

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be fully competent and capable of undertaking the duties attached to the office and be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service.

4. Character

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be of good character.
