Re: Adrenaline Autoinjector Claiming Process

Dear Pharmacist,

The purpose of this circular is to outline the claiming procedure for the Adrenaline autoinjectors that were purchased by community pharmacies for the delivery of the COVID-19 Vaccine service.

Pharmacists can claim under their GMS Pharmacy contractor number using the assigned 5 digit product codes set out below.
