The transition to Additional Superannuation Contribution (ASC) from Pension Related Deduction (PRD) in the Public Service on 1 January 2019 was addressed in HSE HR Circular 001/2019. In this regard, as set out in the attached Department of Health Circular 1/2019, DPER have now advised that Salary Sacrifice in respect of "travel passes" and the "bike to work" scheme is not subject to Additional Superannuation Contribution.

# Transition to Additional Superannuation Contribution (ASC) from Pension Related Deduction (PRD) in the Public Service on 1 January 2019

Dear Sir/Madam,

Further to Department of Health Circular 16/2018 and Department of Public Expenditure and Reform (DPER) Circular 21/2018 please note that DPER have now advised that Salary Sacrifice in respect of "travel passes" and the "bike-to-work" scheme is <u>not</u> subject to ASC.

The relevant provisions are set out in Section 8 of the Public Service Superannuation (Age of Retirement) Act 2018 which amends Section 29 of the Public Service Pay and Pensions Act 2017.

Please bring this circular to the attention of all relevant employees in your organisation. The HSE is also requested to bring this circular to the attention of Section 38 employers.
