Dear Colleagues,

I wish to advise of agreement to provide a 3 month, fixed term contract of employment, as Radiography Assistant, to the cohort of 51 Radiography Students (UCD) currently undertaking their 7 week clinical placement in different Acute Hospitals. This group of 51 UCD final year student radiographers have been identified as a resource which may be required to support the emergency response to the COVID pandemic.

The 3 month temporary contract will commence immediately following conclusion of their clinical placement and will apply from May 18th.

1. Subject to confirmation by individual employers (hospitals), this cohort will be offered a temporary 3 month fixed term contract as a Radiography Assistant.

- The staff involved will be paid on point 1 of the Radiography Assistant salary scale, currently €28,493. Other terms and conditions applicable to the grade of Radiography Assistant will apply, as appropriate
- 3. In as far as practicable, these temporary employees will be based in the hospital in which they undertook their final year clinical placement. In the event of this not being possible, reasonable alternative locations will be explored.
- 4. The Radiography Assistant job description will apply to these employees.
- 5. This initiative is being rolled out, solely in the context of the particular resource challenges that are arising during the current COVID-19 crisis. It shall have no precedential value in respect of radiography or other categories of staff and only applies to the identified current cohort of radiography students from UCD which will become available post clinical placement on 18th May.
