### Re: Sanction for application of pay increase to the grades of Directors of Public Health Medicine and Specialists in Public Health Medicine.

Dear Colleague,

I wish to advise you that the Secretary General of the Department of Health & Children has sanctioned the payment of the 2.5% general round increase withheld under Towards 2016 retrospective to 1<sup>st</sup> September 2008. This is following the agreement brokered by the Labour Relations Commission on 5<sup>th</sup> May 2009 which includes implementation of an interim out-of-hours service; and also in light of the positive development and recognition of the way both grades across the health system have responded to the threat to public health arising from the H1N1(A) virus.

The Secretary General has also sanctioned application of 5% of the pay increases recommended in Report No. 42 of the Review Body on Higher Remuneration in the Public Sector for these grades, in line with the Government decision taken to cap all pay increases recommended by the Review Body in excess of 5%, at that level. These increases are effective from 14<sup>th</sup> September 2007.

The revised consolidated salary scales for these grades (as at the 1<sup>st</sup> September 2008), incorporating these increases are set out in Appendix A. The cost of which must be paid from existing funding allocation.
